HOLY SPIRIT, Give Me A New Song To Sing!

Romans 8

In Romans 8 Paul references the Holy Spirit <u>20</u> times.

- I. The INDWELLING of the Spirit
 - A. There is **NO** condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.
 - B. Romans 8:2-8 tells us <u>HOW</u> this is true.
 - There are <u>TWO</u> different legal standards.
 - Each law has a standard required for <u>JUSTICE</u> to be served.
 - C. If you have the Spirit of Christ, then all that follows <u>APPLIES</u> to you. Romans 8:9-11
- II. Our <u>OBLIGATION</u> to the Spirit
 - A. We have obligations under the <u>LAW</u> of the Spirit.
 - B. We are obligated to put to death what is not of God in <u>OUR LIVES</u>.
 - C. We have Holy Spirit <u>AUTHORITY</u> to do this.
 - D. Provided we <u>SUFFER</u> with Christ
- III. INTERCESSION of the Spirit
 - A. The Holy Spirit helps us in our <u>WEAKNESS</u>.
 - B. "He who searches hearts" is God the <u>FATHER</u>.
 - C. This is us putting complete <u>FAITH</u> in God.

Being free in Christ doesn't mean we have <u>NO</u> standard to live by, it means we have a <u>NEW</u> standard to live by.
