REMOVING ROADBLOCKS

Romans 14

Dogma: SETTLED convictions, such as Articles 1-4

Doctrine: Biblical beliefs specific to <u>TRADITIONS</u>, like baptism Opinion: Personal convictions, often intense, but <u>DISPUTABLE</u>

Romans 14:1 is speaking specifically to OPINION.

- I. As for the one who is <u>WEAK</u> in the <u>FAITH</u>
 - A. Weak: A lack of STRENGTH, POWERLESS
 - B. In the faith: Firm <u>CONVICTION</u>, relying on Jesus
 - C. Faith can be WEAK but still be REAL.
- II. WELCOME them.
 - A. Take them into your fellowship as a **COMPANION**.
 - B. This highlights the need for each of us to evaluate how POTENT or IMPOTENT our faith is.
- III. But not to quarrel over **OPINIONS**
 - A. Don't be that guy!
 - B. Do not invite <u>ANYONE</u> in for the purpose of arguing, disputing, or debating with them.
 - C. Romans 14:13 "Let us not pass judgment on one another <u>ANY LONGER</u>, but rather decide <u>NEVER</u> to put a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of a brother."

Be in the business of <u>BUILDING</u> each other up, <u>REMOVING</u> road blocks, and <u>INVITING</u> others on this journey with Jesus.
