- Because of their <u>DISOBEDIENCE</u> in following God's command to drive out the foreign peoples, God let the Israelites suffer the consequences.
 - A. 350 years later, the people are still facing <u>THREATS</u> from the Philistines.
 - B. When Saul and the Israelites hear Goliath's challenge, they are <u>DISMAYED</u> and <u>GREATLY AFRAID</u>.
 - C. They did <u>THE OPPOSITE</u> of God's command.
- II. Goliath's challenge goes unanswered for 40 days, until DAVID shows up.
 - A. David was a GOOD SHEPHERD.
 - B. David FULLY TRUSTED God.
 - C. He trusted God so much that he went into battle without any armor because it wasn't the <u>RIGHT</u> armor.
 - D. David shows us what a real KING acts like.
- III. Sometimes the things that look the most <u>HELPFUL</u> actually end up being the most <u>BURDENSOME</u>.
 - A. There was no sword in the hand of David, and yet he was perfectly equipped because of his <u>FAITH</u> in the Lord.
 - B. What are we trying too hard to HOLD ON TO?
 - C. What equipment are we **OVERLOOKING**?
