Advent #3: All Creation Sing

LOOKING FOR THE EVIDENCE

Luke 1:39-53

If what Mary heard was <u>TRUE</u> so far, she could <u>TRUST</u> God to finish the work He had started IN her.

- I. Mary went <u>LOOKING</u> for evidence that what she had been told was true.
 - A. Haste: QUICKLY and with PURPOSE.
 - B. Mary was on a MISSION.
 - C. We look for evidence that it is TRUE or NOT TRUE.
 - D. We tend to <u>FIND</u> what we are looking for.
- II. Mary went looking for reasons to <u>BELIEVE</u> and God gave her more than she could have IMAGINED.
 - A. Mary found Elizabeth PREGNANT.
 - B. When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the <u>BABY</u> "...leaped in her womb."
 - C. Elizabeth was <u>FILLED</u> with the Holy Spirit.
- III. Mary could not help but MAGNIFY the Lord.
 - A. Elizabeth and Mary reserved <u>WORSHIP</u> for God.
 - B. She knew her life was forever **CHANGED**.
 - C. Mary knew the course of <u>ISRAEL</u> and of the <u>WORLD</u> had just shifted.
 - D. After staying **THREE** months, Mary returned home.
