Rise and Follow Me: ALL IN!

Luke 5:1-11: John 21:1-19

- I. Peter went from being a follower who <u>SHOWED UP</u> to a disciple who ROSE UP and GREW UP.
 - A. Because of what Peter's seen and heard, he <u>trusts</u> Jesus, and follows Him even when it seems like it will be FRUITLESS.
 - B. When Jesus provides a miracle, Peter responds with HUMILITY.
 - C. He and James and John begin following Jesus ALL IN!
- II. When Jesus walks on the water, Peter again goes all in after Him this time LITERALLY!
 - A. Peter is the only one brave enough to follow Jesus into the STORM.
 - B. And when many other followers turn away, Peter remains <u>COMMITTED</u> to following Jesus all in.
 - C. When Jesus washes the disciples' feet, Peter again goes all in: "Not my feet only, but also my <u>HANDS</u> and my <u>HEAD!</u>"
- III. <u>I'M</u> just like Peter.
 - A. No matter how hard I try to follow Jesus, I will always <u>FALL SHORT</u>.
 - B. But that's WHY Jesus did what He did on the cross.
 - C. Like Peter did, we can run to Jesus without <u>SHAME</u> or CONDEMNATION.
- IV. The command never changes: FOLLOW ME!
