The Gospels are about <u>ENCOUNTERS</u>. The book of Acts is about <u>ACTIVATION</u>. The letters offer INSTRUCTION.

- I. What was the **CULTURE** of both the city and church?
  - A. City of Corinth: a lot like NEW ORLEANS.
  - B. Those in the church had <u>GROWN UP</u> here.
  - C. Where we come from does not <u>DEFINE</u> who we are, but can <u>INFORM</u> the battles we need to face.
  - D. We can be so <u>FAMILIAR</u> with what is not of God that we can become NUMB to the affront it is.
- II. What was Paul's PURPOSE?
  - A. Not to get them SAVED; they were the church.
  - B. So that you might experience God's grace <u>AGAIN</u>: Divine <u>FAVOR</u> poured out <u>LIBERALLY</u>.
- III. What AUTHORITY did Paul have to write to them?
  - A. Based on the RESPONSIBILITY God gave
  - B. Some openly **QUESTIONED** Paul's authority.
  - C. Paul spoke with complete TRANSPARENCY.
