Mark 10:17-23

The ball was in this man's court:
a phrase that comes from TENNIS.
What did Jesus do?

- I. Jesus walked through the door the man OPENED.
 - A. Jesus meets us WHERE WE ARE.
 - B. Jesus did not negate God's COMMANDMENTS.
 - C. To share your faith, be like JESUS.
- II. Jesus LOOKED at this man and LOVED him.
 - A. We need to SEE and FEEL the love of Jesus.
 - B. Jesus does not RESERVE His love.
 - C. Romans 5:8: "...while we were still SINNERS..."
- III. Jesus told him the TRUTH:
 - A. The fullness of God is found in GRACE and TRUTH.
 - B. Because Jesus loved him Jesus saw his POVERTY.
 - C. There are answers that are true for EVERYONE and there are answers that are true for ME.
- IV. Jesus let this man WALK AWAY.
 - A. When God REVEALS what stands between us and our eternal inheritance, the ball is in our court.
 - B. With Jesus, OBSTACLES become GATES.
