- II. We are to be ministers of a COVENANT.
 - A. The root of covenant is CUTTING.
 - B. A weighty, solemn **AGREEMENT**
 - C. How can sinful people enter a <u>RELATIONSHIP</u> with God?
- III. The covenant we offer is NEW.
 - A. The old covenant led to CONDEMNATION.
 - B. The new leads to LIFE.
 - C. The new <u>REDEEMS</u> from the penalty of sin.
- IV. We are <u>SUFFICIENT</u> ministers.
 - A. We are <u>WORTHY</u> to do the assignment.
 - B. It's easy to lock our eyes on our <u>FLAWS</u>.
- V. It's because God MADE us sufficient.
 - A. Will you TRUST that God made you sufficient?
- VI. When we turn to God, HOLY SPIRIT lives in us.
 - A. Holy Spirit does MINISTRY.
 - B. Holy Spirit manifests a new and permanent <u>GLORY</u>.
 - C. Holy Spirit gives FREEDOM as we minister.
 - D. Holy Spirit TRANSFORMS us.
