Luke 6:46

- I. The question: “Why do you call me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ and not do what I tell you?”
 - A. The people had come that day for two reasons:
 - To HEAR what Jesus had to say.
 - To BE HEALED of their diseases.
 - B. Jesus teaches by CONTRASTING the life of a disciple and a non-follower.

- II. To follow Jesus means to live your life DIFFERENTLY.
 - A. Regarding our enemies, Jesus says we are to:
 - DO GOOD to them.
 - BLESS them.
 - PRAY for them.
 - OFFER AND GIVE freely.
 - Be MERCIFUL.
 - B. He says we are to be GENEROUS.
 - C. We are also supposed to be TEACHABLE.
 - D. The spiritual fruit we produce with our lives is dependent upon what we have stored up in our HEARTS.
 - E. Even though these things are hard to do, Jesus calls us to them because IT'S WHAT GOD DOES FOR US!

- III. Everyone who COMES to Jesus, who HEARS His words, and who DOES them is building on a strong foundation.
