Building a Forever House

2 Samuel 7:1-16

- I. Our GOOD intentions don't always line up with God's PLANS.
 - A. We sometimes get it BACKWARD and assume we know what God WANTS.
 - B. God's presence is not LOCATION DEPENDANT.

- II. God is a master at turning the tables into something UNEXPECTED.
 - A. God's covenant with David is completely ONE-WAY, GOD-DEPENDANT.
 - B. God may say no to our PLANS, but sometimes we get back more than we could have HOPED for.
 - C. Seeing God's past FAITHFULNESS can make it easier to TRUST him in the future.

- III. God's plans will emerge through our human MESSINESS.
 - A. God's plans never SWERVE off track.
 - B. God's plans contain HOPE.

Conclusion

- This is all about God's ETERNAL plan.
- God doesn't need to READJUST or move to a BACKUP plan.
- This GOOD NEWS is for everyone!
