

Receiving A Call

Nehemiah 1

- I. As Nehemiah prays, he first remembers God's CHARACTER and FAITHFULNESS.
 - A. These are God's CONSTANTS.
 - B. God will keep his COVENANT.
 - C. God's love is STEADFAST.

- II. Nehemiah asks for REPENTANCE.
 - A. There is HOPE in repentance.
 - B. LEADERS may have to repent for the GROUP.

- III. Nehemiah begs God to REMEMBER his promises.
 - A. There's something PERSONAL and VULNERABLE with asking someone to remember a promise.
 - B. Reminders come from NEED.
 - C. Reminders come with RISK.
 - D. Reminders imply RELATIONSHIP.

- IV. Nehemiah wants to see SUCCESS.
 - A. He asks for this at the END of the prayer.
 - B. Success comes from PARTNERING with God, not our own STRENGTH.

Reflection Questions:

1. Big or small, have you recently felt like God has placed a new burden or call on your life? If so, do you need to ask God for a clear vision for what this call may be?
2. Are there any areas of your life that you need to come before him in repentance?
3. Is it time to step out or is it time to wait? Maybe you've been given a call but have been waiting to hear that it's time to get started on that call.
